JRCC Short Term Missions Application

Trip Date: Spring Break, 2017. *Approximately Saturday, March 11th to Saturday, March 18th.*

Jericho Ridge Community Church is planning our 10th team trip to Guatemala! The focus of the trip is to share our love of Jesus through actions, specifically to orphans, widows, the physically challenged and poor families.

Once again our team will be serving under the direction of Chris and Donna Mooney of Bethel Ministries International. Starting in Chimaltenango, we will work where needed.

The plan this year is to once again build 1 or 2 small homes and distribute food and clothing to families in need. As a member of the team you may have the opportunity to participate in a local church service and interact with physically challenged children such as those at Hermano Pedro Orphanage (in Antigua).

The main focus of our trip will be a wheelchair distribution. Since plans may change once we arrive, based on local circumstances, we will follow the leadership of our partners. Be prepared to be spiritually, mentally and physically stretched.

We invite people from JRCC to apply by October 30th, after that date we will extend invitations to others who are interested. Individual trip costs are anticipated to be between \$1700 and \$1900, depending on flight costs, in-country expenses and exchange rates. A \$100 deposit will be due by November 6th, then \$600 by Jan 15th and the final balance will be due by Feb 15th, 2017.



All applications will be reviewed and prayed through and applicants will be notified. Our aim is to have the team finalized by November 30.

We are looking forward to a fantastic trip. Past participants have been amazed at how God has worked in their lives as they stepped out in faith and served Him in Guatemala. This may be YOUR year!

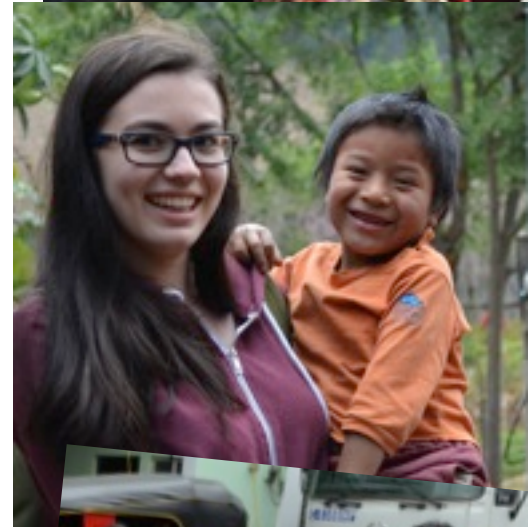

There are two categories of fundraising: Personal and Group. Each team member must commit to raising funds towards our team projects ie wheelchairs, homes, food and clothing. Please be aware that a passport is required to travel, both through the USA, Mexico and Guatemala. Your passport must be valid for a minimum 6 months prior to date of entry. Along with passports, appropriate immunizations and medical preparation may be required.
