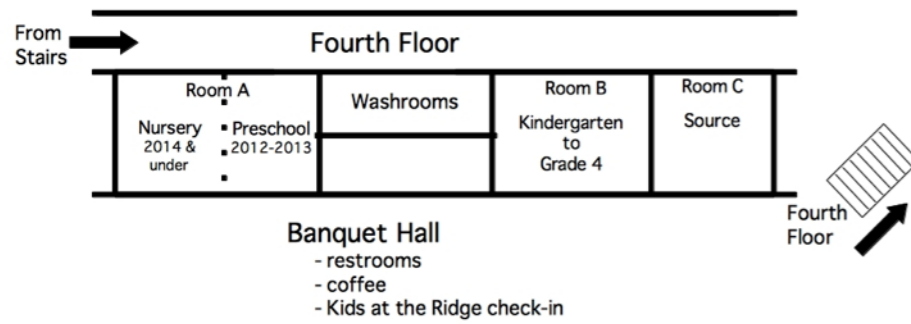
### Christmas Eve Gathering - December 24

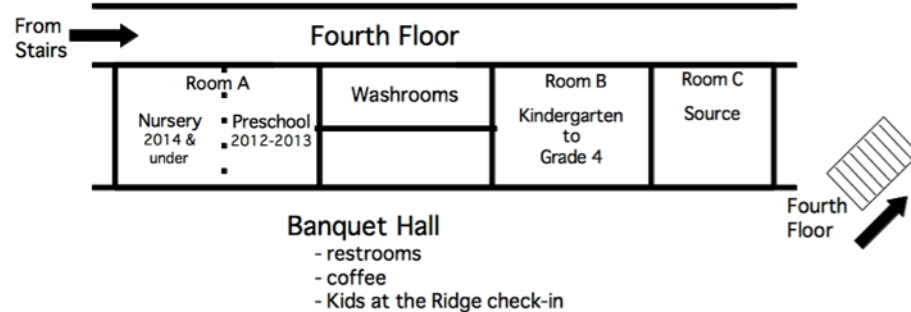
