Guatemala Clothing Drive

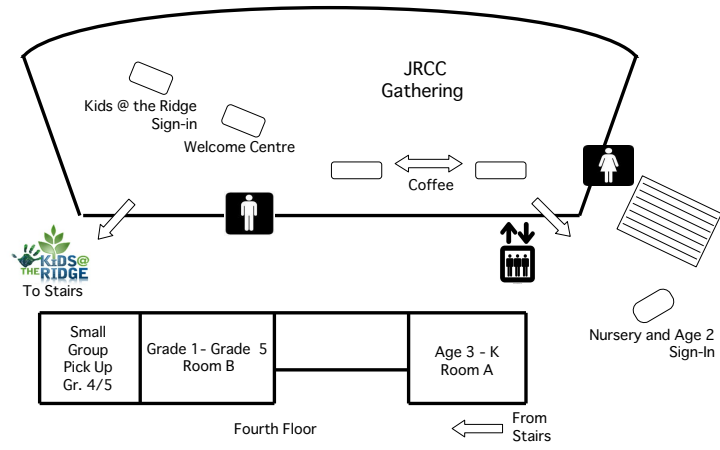

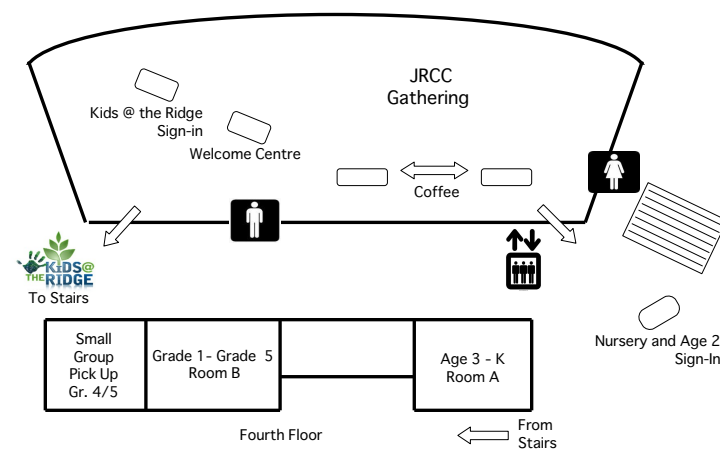
